Subject: Nomination of East Sanford to the National Register of Historic Places

The State of North Carolina, Department of Cultural Resources Office of Archives and History certifies that East Sanford Historic District located in Sanford; Lee County has been entered in The National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of Interior upon nomination by the State Historic Preservation Office under provision of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966.

The National Register is a list of properties “significant in American history, architecture, archaeology, and culture – a comprehensive index of significant physical evidence of our national patrimony.” Properties listed herein deserve to be preserved by their owners as a par of the cultural heritage of our nation. The East Sanford Historic District was entered into the register on December 28, 2010.
