

**City of Sanford Historic Preservation Commission  
Public Hearing Notice**

Notice is hereby given that the Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Monday, July 26, 2021**, the hearing will be held in **the Buggy Conference Room in the Buggy Building, 115 Chatham Street Sanford, NC 27330**. The hearing will begin at **6:00 p.m.** or as soon as deemed practical by the Chairman of the Historic Preservation Commission. The Historic Preservation Commission will consider:

**COA-21-55 - Application by the City of Sanford, property owners of 106 Charlotte Avenue (Duke Energy Pavilion), who wish to remove the Duke Energy Pavilion signage and install a screen, 14 feet long and 7 feet tall, that will be used to show the performers on the stage, to be better viewed by attendees. The screen can also be used to announce event schedules and announcements. The screen will also be able to show movies during the day in addition to dusk. A camera will be mounted in/on the Depot Building and will be focused on the stage. A cable will be installed, underground, between the panel and the camera, so stage performances can be displayed on the screen.**
