



# REVIEW AND PERMITTING PROCESSES

## Residential Swimming Pools

*This review and permitting process overview is intended to serve as a guide for citizens seeking to obtain permits for the construction of a new swimming pool (either above-ground or in-ground). The steps below are a brief overview of the process by which a property owner or licensed contractor can obtain a building permit.*

### Step 1 – Packet Submittal (Zoning, Inspections, & Environmental Health Review)

The permitting process has been consolidated to allow for **concurrent reviews** of building plans, site plans and, if needed, the proposed septic system. Please complete a [Residential Project Application Packet](#) and include the following with your packet submittal:

- A **site plan**, which must include:
  - The location of the proposed structure
  - The distance(s) between the proposed structure and the front, rear, and side property lines
  - The location of the existing or proposed driveway
- A set of **building plans**
- **Septic system information** and layout/site plan (if a septic system is located on site)

### Step 2 – Building Permit Issued or Resubmittal Notice Sent
