



REVIEW AND PERMITTING PROCESSES

Residential Single-Family Dwellings – Manufactured Homes

This review and permitting process overview is intended to serve as a guide for citizens seeking to obtain building permits for the placement and set-up of a manufactured home. The steps below are a brief overview of the process by which a property owner or licensed contractor can obtain a building permit.

Step 1 – Packet Submittal (Zoning, Inspections, & Environmental Health Review)

The permitting process has been consolidated to allow for **concurrent reviews** of building and site plans. Please complete a [Manufactured Home Application Packet](#) and include the following:

- A **site plan**, which must include:
 - The location of the proposed structure
 - The distance(s) between the proposed structure and the front, rear, and side property lines
 - The location of the existing or proposed driveway
- Applicable **information from the manufactured home manufacturer**.
- **Septic system information** and layout/site plan (*if private septic system is being utilized*)

Addresses for new home construction will be assigned by staff and finalized by the time a building permit is issued for your home.

Step 2 – Building Permit Issued *or* Resubmittal Notice Sent
